DOES FATHER/MALE GUARDIAN NEED TO ATTEND?

Fathers must accompany Boys in Kindergarten to 2nd Grade (Ranger Kids). Fathers are strongly encouraged to join if their Boys are in 3rd-6th Grade (Discovery Rangers) as the trip will be a great chance for fathers and sons to spend quality time together.

DO I NEED TO BRING A TENT?

If you have a tent it would be helpful if you are able to bring it. If you don't own one we will provide a dry place to sleep. Boys in Kindergarten to 2nd grade will need to be in the same tent as their Father. We will have a few bigger tents with supervision where the older boys can pick a spot to stay the night.

ARE THERE WAIVER FORMS TO SIGN?

Yes there will be two waiver forms to sign, one from Cedar Park Church and one from Cedar Springs Camp. Those will be available on Wednesdays in March (at Ranger Classes), in the Children's Ministry Office and on-line.

DOES MY BOY NEED TO BE ATTENDING ROYAL RANGER PROGRAMS IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE?

No, this event is hosted by the Royal Ranger program and boys will earn badges while up at camp but it is open to all boys and their fathers from the Church.

CAN MY OLDER BOY BRING HIS POCKET KNIFE?

No, unless your 3rd through 6th grade boy has completed the Pocket Knife Safety lessons with Commander Cummings. We will be reinforcing with the boys how to properly use pocketknives while camping. There will be a zero tolerance for boys who are using their pocketknives inappropriately. If that happens they will be confiscated for the weekend.
